<b>Fast Facts:</b> Chartered by the Commonwealth in 1855, Penn State is a public co-educational university with 19 commonwealth campuses and 5 special-mission campuses statewide, including a distance learning opportunity through World Campus. A leader in Continuing and Distance Education, Penn State began offering correspondence courses in 1892 and, at that time, was one of three universities in the country providing that opportunity. Penn State employs more than 40,000 employees. The University has a faculty statewide of nearly 5,500 including 2,900+ at University Park. Having conferred in excessive of 612,000 degrees since 1855, one in every 115 Americans with a college degree is a graduate of Penn State. From most recent figures Penn State's worldwide living alumni numbered 459,000+.

<b>Fast Facts:</b> Founded in 1846, Bucknell is a private university located on a 450 acre campus offering more than 50 majors and 60 minors including pre-professional programs in law and medicine. Bucknell has 280 faculty members and 720 non-faculty employees. All classes are taught by faculty. It is 17th among U. S. Liberal Arts colleges for the number of graduates receiving doctrates. 89% of students graduate within 5 years.

<b>Fast Facts:</b> An independent, private, 4 year co-educational Liberal Arts and Science college founded in 1876. The 110 acre main campus is supplemented by the 315 acre Baker-Henry Preserve & Baker Peace Chapel plus a 365 acre Environmental Studies Field Station on nearby Raystown Lake. Juniata offers an unique two advisor system and has a 95% graduation rate in their 4 year degree programs. As of 10/1/2006, their total staff of 403 includes includes approx 99 full-time and 31 part-time faculty members. 91% of their faculty hold a terminal degree.

Campuses include approximately 200 acres in Lock Haven and 12.9 acres in Clearfield. LHU is well known for programs in Teacher Education and Television Broadcasting Communication and is one of the few colleges in the country to offer a program in Sports Medicine as part of their 60+ undergraduate and 4 graduate programs. All classes are taught by professors; their faculty numbers about 286. In addition to their undergraduate and graduate programs, continuing and distance education programs are available.

<b>Fast Facts:</b> Founded in 1855 as a teacher's college, Millersville offers a wide range of graduate and undergraduate majors in the areas of science, mathematics, education, humanities and social sciences. Located on 250 acres in the heart of historic Lancaster County it provides a tranquil campus featuring a pleasing mix of historic buildings and modern structures. Its central location affords easy access to the culture and fun in major cities like Baltimore, Philadelphia, Washington, D.C. and New York City. The average class size is 25 students with a student/faculty ratio of 18:1. With more than 50,000 graduates worldwide, a recent survey of graduates indicated 75% were hired within three months of their graduation and 97% were currently employed.

The first year retention rate is 82% and the graduation/rentention rate is 61%. Their number of alumni exceeds 15,000.
