Many of the first students enrolled were disabled veterans from World War I who needed immediate training. As a result of legislature, Williamsport Technical Institute became Williamsport Area Community College in 1965 and, since 1989 has been Pennsylvania College of Technology, *an affiliate of Pennsylvania State University and offers degrees <i>that work</i>.</p> <p>Over 140 courses for Bachelor Degrees, Minors, Certificates, Associate Degrees &amp; Competency Credentials are offered.
